Domestic Violence was part of Xenia's life for many years from 1990 to 2005 and she now believes that her past does not have to negatively impact her life but positively motivate and direct her future by creating change in the attitudes and mindsets of society.

She is a mouthpiece for the voiceless as she exposes what society would like to shut down such as sexual abuse and domestic violence. 'We have to stand up for people who cannot stand up for themselves, I for one cannot stay silent anymore.' she says.

She is often compared to Xena Warrior Princess, not just because of her name but also because of her fighting spirit. Her strength and determination is often hidden amongst her gentle demeanour.

This book shows a tenacity and warrior mentality can be developed to conquer circumstances beyond our own control. This is her story of how she has turned the ashes of a broken life into an ornament of beauty.

Xenia is an international author of a 3-book series written to empower families, educators and other professionals to equip this and future generations with self-protective behaviours.





Statistics

In 2018:

- 3,649,541 children entered the education system in Australia
- 1 in 5 = 20% of these will be SA before they leave school = 729,908.2
- Inc. pre school kids this equals approx. 59,000 children a year

Australian Domestic Violence Statistics:

- By 10 a.m. today the police will have received 300 calls
- In Australia, DV related incidences kill 1 women a week and 1 man a month
- DV is the principle cause of homelessness by women and children
- 1in 5 women receive sexual harassment at work
- Cost Australian economy \$22 billion a year

Worldwide in 2018

- 5 people killed by sharks
- 5000 people killed by lightening
- 50,000 women killed in DV related incidents = 137 women a day





